

**St. Pius X Catholic School Dress Code Policy**  
**2015-2016**

**Daily Dress Code (Non Mass Days)**

The school logo is only required on the navy Mass uniform tops

**\*Embellishments of any type are not allowed**

**Jumpers, skirts, pants, and shorts:**

- \* Navy, khaki or black jumpers or skirts, length : right above the knee to knee length
- \* Navy, khaki or black pants regular length (Button or elastic waist. No leggings, windpants, sweatpants, pajama pants)
- \* Dark denim
- \* White, black, or navy leggings or tights (Never to be worn alone. Can be worn under a jumper, skirt or skort.  
Are required to be worn under a jumper, skirt or skort, Oct.15-April 15)
- \* Plain black or brown belt – optional  
**Sept.-Oct. 15, April 15-end of the school year**
- \* Navy, khaki or black shorts-length: right above the knee to knee length
- \* Navy, khaki or black capri length pants
- \* Plain black or brown belt – optional

**Dress shirts, polo shirts, turtlenecks, and sweatshirts:**

- \*White or black or navy turtlenecks or crew neck tee shirts (must be worn under a polo shirt never alone)
- \* Polo shirts, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- \* Button-down dress shirts with a collar, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- \* Cardigan sweaters, any solid color (worn over a collared dress-code shirt)
- \* Crew-neck sweatshirts no hood, any solid color (worn over a collared dress-code shirt)
- \* Black or navy zip-up sweatshirts no hood (worn over a collared dress-code shirt)

**Footwear:**

- \* Dress shoes with a covered toe and covered heel no more than 1 inch heel
- \* Dress boots no more than a 1 inch heel
- \* Sandals/shoes with a back (Sept.-Oct. 15 and April 15- end of the school year), no flip-flop sandals
- \* Regular sport, athletic shoes

\* Please note:

Solid color means no embellishments of any kind

**Embellishments include but not limited to: embroidery, beading and rhinestones, screen printing, name brand logos, decorative zippers or buttons, skirts with thumb holes, lace that decorates the bottom of a shirt/cami that will be worn under another shirt and is visible.**

## Mass Days and most Field Trips

**All navy tops are required to have the school logo**

### Jumpers, skirts, skorts and pants

- \* Khaki jumpers, skirts or skorts -length should be right above the knee
- \* Khaki dress pants flat or pleated front, regular length- no cargo pants
- \* Plain black or brown belt- optional
- \* White leggings or tights (Never to be worn alone. Can be worn under a khaki jumper, skirt or skort.  
Are required to be worn under a jumper, skirt, or skort, Oct. 15-April 15)

### Dress shirts, polo shirts, turtlenecks, and sweatshirts:

- \* White turtlenecks or long sleeve crew-neck tees (must be worn under a logoed polo shirt, never alone)
- \* Navy blue logoed polo shirts, long or short sleeve
- \* Navy blue logoed crew-neck fleece, cardigan, or sweatshirts, no hood (worn over a logoed dress-code shirt)

### Footwear:

- \* Dress shoes with a covered toe and covered heel no more than 1 inch heel
- \* Dress boots no more than a 1 inch heel
- \* Sandals/shoes with a back (Sept.-Oct. 15 and April 15- end of the school year)
- \* Regular sport-tennis shoes

## Non-Uniform Dress Days

- \* Denim jeans or other pants without holes or fraying.
- \* T-shirts or sweatshirts with appropriate sayings and pictures. (Shirts must be long enough to cover the midriff and the lower back).
- \* Capri length and knee length shorts (Sept. – Oct. 15, April 15-end of the school year)

## Dress Code Enforcement-per year

1. Parents will check that their children are dressed appropriately for school.
2. Teachers will check the students during the first hour of the school day.

### **If a student is out or dress code:**

1<sup>st</sup> Warning- A dress code violation slip will be issued by the teacher. Clothing from the uniform closet will be given to the student to wear for the remainder of the day. A parent will sign and return the warning slip with the washed clothing.

2<sup>nd</sup> Warning- A dress code violation slip will be issued by the teacher. Clothing from the uniform closet will be given to the student to wear for the remainder of the day. A parent will sign and return the warning slip with the washed clothing.

3<sup>rd</sup> Warning- Parents will be called by the principal to bring different clothes for the student to wear. A dress code violation slip will be issued by the principal. A parent will sign and return the warning slip.

**The student will not be able to participate in the next non-uniform dress day.**
