They also have our school logo on file.

Daily Dress Code (Non Mass Days)

Jumpers, skirts, pants, and shorts:

Embellishments of any type are not allowed

- *Navy, khaki or black jumpers or skirts, knee length (black or white leggings or tights must be worn Oct. 15-April 15)
- * Navy, khaki or black dress pants flat or pleated front, regular length
- * Dark denim
- *Navy, khaki or black knee length dress shorts, flat or pleated front (Sept.-Oct. 15, April 15-end of the school year)
- * Navy, khaki or black capri length pants flat or pleated front (Sept. Oct.15, April 15-end of the school vear)
- * Plain black or brown belt optional

Dress shirts, polo shirts, turtlenecks, and sweatshirts:

Embellishments of any type are not allowed

- *White or black turtlenecks (worn under a short sleeve polo shirt or sweatshirt)
- * Polo shirts, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- * Button-down dress shirts, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- * Cardigan sweaters, any solid color (worn over a collared dress-code shirt or turtleneck)
- * Crew-neck sweatshirts (worn over a collared dress-code shirt or turtleneck) no hood, any solid color
- * Fleece zip-up sweatshirts (worn over a collared dress-code shirt or turtleneck) no hood, black or navy

Footwear:

- *Dress shoes with a covered toe and covered heel no more than 1 inch heel
- *Dress boots no more than a 1 inch heel
- *Sandals with a back (Sept.-Oct. 15 and April 15- end of the school year)
- *Regular sport, tennis shoes
- *White or black leggings or tights

Mass Days and most Field Trips

Jumpers, skirts and pants

- *Khaki jumpers or skirts-knee length (white leggings or tights must be worn Oct. 15-April 15)
- *Khaki dress pants flat or pleated front, regular length- no cargo pants
- *Plain black or brown belt- optional

Dress shirts, polo shirts, turtlenecks, and sweatshirts:

- * White turtlenecks or long sleeve shirts (must be worn under a logoed short sleeve polo shirt or sweatshirt)
- * Navy blue logoed polo shirts, long or short sleeve
- * Navy blue logoed crew-neck fleece or sweatshirts (worn over a logoed dress-code shirt) no hood

Footwear:

- *Dress shoes with a covered toe and covered heel no more than 1 inch heel
- *Dress boots no more than a 1 inch heel
- * Sandals with a back (Sept.-Oct. 15 and April 15- end of the school year)
- *Regular sport-tennis shoes
- *White leggings or tights

Non-Uniform Dress Days

- *Denim jeans or other pants without holes or fraying.
- *T-shirts or sweatshirts with appropriate sayings and pictures. (Shirts must be long enough to cover the midriff and the lower back). No references to violence, alcohol, smoking, or drugs
- *Capri length and knee length shorts (Sept. Oct. 15, April 15-end of the school year)

Dress Code Enforcement

- 1. Parents will check that their children are dressed appropriately for school.
- 2. Teachers will check the students during the first hour of the school day.

If a student is out or dress code:

- 1 st Warning- A dress code violation slip will be issued by the teacher. Clothing from the uniform closet will be given to the student to wear for the remainder of the day. A parent will sign and return the warning slip with the washed clothing.
- 2^{nd} Warning- A dress code violation slip will be issued by the teacher. Clothing from the uniform closet will be given to the student to wear for the remainder of the day. A parent will sign and return the warning slip with the washed clothing.
- 3^{rd} Warning- Parents will be called by the principal to bring different clothes for the student to wear. A dress code violation slip will be issued by the principal. A parent will sign and return the warning slip. The student will not be able to participate in the next nonuniform dress day.
